Summer Day Camp 2018

- DATES:** Wednesday, June 6 – Wednesday, August 8, 2018 (Closed for Independence Day: Wednesday, July 4)
- HOURS:** 7:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m.; weekdays
- AGES:** Students entering Grades 1 through 6 in fall, 2018
- COST:** (per child)
Application Fee - \$40 (**non-refundable if application turned in before April 6th**)
Application Fee - \$55 (**non-refundable if application turned in after April 6th**)
Full-Time Camp Fees - \$135.00 per week (4-5 days)
Part-Time Camp Fees - \$38.00 per day (1-3 days per week)
T-Shirt – Included with application fee
Summer Bridge workbook – Included with application fee
Field Trip Fees – varies, according to trips taken

You are free to select as many or as few days and weeks as you will need. However, because we hire personnel and purchase supplies based on enrollment, **you are obligated by contract to pay for your selections.** All changes to your contract must be approved by the director by **MAY 1st**.

- LUNCH:** Each child needs to bring a drink and a daily lunch that needs no refrigeration or heating.
- DRESS CODE:** No open toed shoes or bare feet are allowed. Please follow guidelines of Christian modesty (no bare midriffs or skimpy clothing) for summer play clothes and bathing suits. (one piece or tankinis only)
- SNACKS:** The camp provides afternoon snacks and morning juice breaks. Children may bring breakfast
- ACTIVITIES:** Outdoor play - playgrounds and grassy areas, water play - sprinklers, water toys (once per week)
Indoor games - board games, group games, puzzles, arts and crafts
Reading time – Students bring a book from home or listen to a story be read.
Academics - “Catch Up, Keep Up” time for math and reading (not to replace individualized tutoring)
Weekly Field Trips
Special activities - such as sports, crafts

Rules of Conduct

- Be orderly at all times (including classrooms, restrooms, and outside).
- Practice cleanliness, consideration of others, politeness, and kindness.
- No gum or gum chewing on campus.
- Abuse of facilities will not be tolerated.
- Profane, obscene, suggestive, or sacrilegious language is not permitted.
- Disrespect, insolence, and disobedience to teachers and staff will not be tolerated.
- Respect others and their property.

Those who find that they cannot comply with the rules of conduct will be withdrawn from the camp program.
